The Natural Fertility Enhancement Active Learning Module

The Ovulation Method Research and Reference Centre of Australia Ltd, an Accredited Provider with the College of General Providers will offer a 6 hour interactive Active Learning Module entitled Natural Fertility Enhancement on 4th May in Melbourne. This ALM will attract **40 Category 1 (Women's Health) points from the RACGP QA&CPD Program** as well as points from the RANZCOG and the Australian College of Midwives Inc. Participants will be expected to complete a Predisposing and Reinforcing Activity as well as a Course evaluation before allocation of points.

The Natural Fertility Enhancement ALM is aimed at all health professionals who are interested in assisting women to protect their reproductive health as well as those working in the area of assisting couples to achieve a pregnancy.

The Natural Fertility Enhancement ALM is an interactive program and participants will be offered presentations by experts from Australia, Chile, Ireland and the USA. Participants are encouraged to be actively involved in discussions and to work through Case Studies as offered by the presenters.

This program will cover the ovarian and pituitary hormones in a normal fertile cycle as well as explain the variants of ovarian activity from Menarche to Menopause. Sessions will cover the recognition of patterns of normal ovarian activity and patterns indicating an abnormality which require further medical investigation. Through the use of Case Studies, women experiencing ovarian dysfunction will be followed through to normal ovarian function. Participants will be given the opportunity to discuss relevant treatment options.

When a woman presents to a medical practitioner with concerns that she has not been able to conceive, the response is often to assist conception rather than to investigate the cause of fertility suppression. This ALM will give participants the opportunity to consider the treatment options which will not only result in a high level of pregnancy achievement but also provide better reproductive health outcomes in the long term.
